There will be administrative and warehouse responsibilities which include cataloging equipment and parts, and maintaining a well-organized and clean environment. Periodic heavy lifting is involved.

Key Responsibilities

- Repair, clean and maintain various healthcare equipment, such as power and manual wheelchairs, walkers, scooters, lifts and other assistive devices
- Maintain inventory control of incoming and outgoing health equipment
- Work with others in a cooperative and professional manner
- Ensure storage and workshop facility is kept in safe working order and OH+S regulations are adhered to
- Perform other duties as required

Key Qualifications

- Minimum high school diploma
- Mechanical aptitude – prior healthcare equipment experience is considered an asset
- Valid driver's license, driver's abstract and criminal record check
- WHMIS and valid first aid would be considered assets
